

## Winnebago Community School District Bond Information

On March 20, 2018, community members of Winnebago Community Unit School District #323 will vote on a \$7.5 million dollar building-bond referendum question. The focus of this bond is to pay for building improvements mandated by the Health/Life Safety process.

### Here is a brief overview of what the bonds will be used for

| Building Improvements   | Firm Fixed Amount  |

| • Abate Asbestos & Fire Safety  | \$1,290,000        |
| • Replace Mechanical Systems  | \$1,200,000        |
| • Replace Gym Bleachers and Flooring                                      | \$675,000          |
| • Structural Reinforcement, Interior Renovations, and Gym Divider Curtain | \$440,000          |
| • Security: Video Surveillance, Controlled Access, and Intercom           | \$435,000          |
| • Security Entrance, Repair Building Envelope, Doors & Door Closers       | \$850,000          |
| • Repaving/Repairing Pavement   | \$2,610,000        |
| <b>Total</b>  | <b>\$7,500,000</b> |

### How will this impact your taxes?

If the building bonds are approved, Winnebago Community Unit School District property taxpayers can expect a net 23-cent tax rate decrease because the annual payments on the new bonds will be lower than the annual payments on existing District bonds that have recently been fully repaid.
